





# The American Dental Society of Europe JOIN US FOR THE 123<sup>rd</sup> MEETING AT HOTEL DE ROME BERLIN, GERMANY, June 22<sup>nd</sup> - 24<sup>th</sup> 2017

As well as offering an excellent Scientific Programme, we are also putting together a great Social Programme. On the Thursday there will be a day tour to Potsdam, which was the residence of the Prussian Kings and the last German Emperor. Around the city there are a series of interconnected lakes and cultural landmarks, in particular the parks and palaces of Sans Souci, the largest World Heritage Site in Germany. The Potsdam Conference, the major



post-World War II conference between the victorious Allies, was held at another palace in the area, the Cecilienhof. For the first evening we are planning a get together dinner at one of the restaurants / beer gardens located at the side of one of the many lakes, just outside of Berlin. The Friday will be free for you to explore the many



interesting sites Berlin has to offer. To name a few, the Museum Island in the Spree river, the Postdammer Platz, the impressive Jewish Memorial, the Brandenburger Gate and Checkpoint Charlie. For the Friday evening we are planning to have a Civic reception at Humboldt University, which has an extensive list of notable Alumni and Nobel prize winners. After the reception, we will have dinner at the rooftop of the German



Parliament building, the 'Bundestag'. On Saturday morning we will have a guided walking tour that will take you to some of the sites in Berlin you may not so easily discover. For the Saturday evening we will have our annual Gala banquet, which will be held at the historic ballroom of the Hotel de Rome.
